

REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL MEETING OF ELECTORS

We, the undersigned, request that a special meeting of the electors of the Town of Bassendean be held to discuss the proposal for a three unit development at 27L (lot 100) Hyland Street in Bassendean.

We strongly object to this application being decided under delegated authority as the proposal, as presented, undermines a central framework of Town Planning Scheme 4A which aims to consolidate the surrounding public open space.

We do not object to the site being developed *per se* as long as the development does not divide the Bindaring wetland via causeway access. The current proposal, if approved with causeway access, would permanently undermine a long held vision for Bindaring Park; that of being able to unify the existing wetlands into a single parcel of land, maximising its ecological integrity. This plan has been in existence for over 30 years.

The land has been zoned for this purpose since January 1981.
